



REPSOL – MONTESA HRC



World Indoor Trial Championship
4th round.

Toni Bou wins and regains world championship leadership. Takahisa Fujinami, in second position, completes the success of Repsol-Montesa HRC.

Barcelona, 04.02.2007. - A historic result for the Repsol-Montesa HRC team with the double victory of their 4-stroke bikes in the Barcelona Indoor Trial, whose 30th edition took place this Sunday in the Palau Sant Jordi. Toni Bou (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) obtained an unquestionable victory, his third in this edition of the World Championship and his second consecutive victory in this event, while Takahisa Fujinami (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) added to the success of the team with his second position, achieved on very difficult zones. With this victory, Bou has regained his leadership in the general classification, and Takahisa Fujinami rose to fourth position, just one point away from the positions of honour. Dougie Lampkin (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) was fourth in the classification lap, which Bou and Fujinami ended occupying the first two positions, with 8 and 10 points, respectively. In the play-off, Bou left the other two finalists behind from the beginning, with an impeccable performance. Fujinami already had his second position on the podium assured three zones before finishing the thirteen on the course.

Toni Bou: *"This victory in the Palau Sant Jordi, in the 30th edition of the Barcelona Indoor and before my supporters, has been sensational and moving. The fact I regained the leadership of the Championship makes my satisfaction ever greater. After last week's disaster in Marseille, today two of my main rivals were out of the play-off and this has proven once again that that situation can change completely in each event. So we'll continue moving step by step, celebrating the good moments but always aware that we are in a period of adaptation and it's necessary to carry on working hard"*.

Takahisa Fujinami: *"To be in the final here in Barcelona and to reach the podium for the first time this season in such a difficult trial has been fantastic. And even more so after winning the second position and contributing to this great result for the team"*.

Dougie Lampkin: *"I'm delighted with my result in the first lap. The Barcelona trial is always very difficult and I really didn't think I'd finish fourth. Of course, I'm also very happy about the team results and by how Toni won"*.

The fifth scoring event for the Indoor Trial World Championship will be in Lisbon, next Saturday, February 10th.
