European Trial Women's Championship 3th round



A sixth continental title for Laia Sanz, all consecutive.

Hobol (Norway), 18.08.2007. - Laia Sanz (Montesa-HRC Cota 4RT) has validated her title as Champion in the European Trial Women's Championship for the sixth time running, an award obtained with her victory in the third and last event of the championship, held this Saturday in Hobol, Norway. This time, in a very difficult race, Laia Sanz showed her true colours as a champion, setting the pace from the very first lap, which practically guaranteed her victory, and of course, the championship.











Laia Sanz: "A good trial, another victory and a new title. I can't complain. Today's event didn't have dangerous zones, but they were selective, where you could show your worth and also recover points lost by mistakes. I wish all the trials were like this one. Regarding the title, what can I say? It was one of my principal objectives for this season and I got it, so I'm completely satisfied. Now the most important challenge is to win the World Championship again".

Laia Sanz has won all three events of the current edition of the European Trial Women's Championship. Born on December 11th 1985 in Corbera de Llobregat (Barcelona), she has been a member of the Repsol-Montesa HRC team since 2004 and currently holds six continental titles and seven World Championships.
