A Rain Of Podiums For Sherco

It was feared the conditions would be terrible for this race, with a week of rain, wind and snow in La Bresse. However it was a rain of 6 podiums for Sherco that marked this weekend in France.

On Saturday, with a total of 22 points, **Albert Cabestany** placed 3rd behind Toni Bou (Montesa) who had 10 points and Adam Raga (GasGas) who had 8 points but he finished ahead of Jeroni Fajardo (Beta) based on the number of zeros.

On Sunday, **Albert** finished third again with 14 points, he was 14 points behind Jeroni Fajardo and 7 behind Toni Bou. This time the tie breaker was based on time and **Albert** was 5 minutes behind Jeroni Fajardo.

In the World Championship, **Albert Cabestany** is fourth with 30 points Toni Bou has 37 points, Adam Raga has 31 points and Jeroni Fajardo also has 30 points.

In the Junior class, it was a great weekend for the Sherco riders. **Alexandre Ferrer** continues to demonstrate his skill. In the first round on Saturday, an unfortunate five could have been a distraction, but it only motivated **Alexandre** to ride even better. A clean second round assured him of his first victory with six points ahead of Francesco Moret (Montesa) who had 16 points and Pol Tarres (JTG) who also had 16 points. **Cedric Tempier** finished with an excellent ride and finished in fourth place with 22 points.

On Sunday, **Alexandre** produced another superb ride, and won with 9 points. **Cedric Tempier** finished with 14 points, he flaunted his outstanding qualities with a 2 point second round which earned him his first podium in the Junior Worlds. With a total of 14 points, he finished in second place. Benoit Dagnicourt (Beta) finished third behind the two Sherco riders and mounted the 3rd step of the podium with 17 points.

In the overall Junior standings, **Alexandre Ferrer** leads with 40 points, **Cedric Tempier** is second with 30 points. Hakon Pedersen is in 13th position with 8 points.

In the Youth Championship, **Oriol Noguera** was also on the podium for his first race in the Worlds. On Saturday, he was the author of a quality race, his 32 points placed him third behind Bradley Cox (Beta) with 28 points and Steven Coquelin (GasGas) who had 24 points.

Oriol finished off of the podium on Sunday. He was fourth with 37 points, he was surpassed by Steven Coquelin who had 33points, Bradley Cox with 32 points and a surprising Sverre Lundevold (Beta) who had 17 points.

In the overall Youth standings, **Oriol Noguera** is third with 28 points, he is behind Bradley Cox who has 34 points and Steven Coquelin who has 35 points. Luke Walker is eighth with 15 points.
